CONTRACT AND QUESTIONNAIRE FOR PET HANDOVER

IN HABITAT ASSOCIATION

Dear pet owners,

when handing your pet over to us, there are several pieces of information that are necessary for us to get to know you pet and you in detail, and in order to be able to ensure the best possible care for your pet in Habitat Association. Your pet can't be handed over if he/ she is ill with an infectious disease.

If we determine that your pet is ill with an infectious disease, you as the owner, will be responsible for all damages (treatment of your pet and other pets of the disease is contracted from your pet and all other cost related to this).

Before receiving your pet we need to see the documentation/confirmation that your pet is vaccinated against rabies and viral diseases regularly, and treated for fleas and ticks.

If your pet is not treated accordingly for ectoparasites before entering the common area, he/she will be treated at your expense.

Article 1. Habitat is obliged to:

- regularly feed the pet during his/her stay, with food recommended by the owner
- maintain necessary hygiene
- disable any unwanted contacts with other animals
- respect all specific services of care agreed upon with the owner

Article 2. The owner is obliged to inspect outdoor and indoor space and establish that his/her pet can safely stay here without the possibility of escape or injury.

Article 3. During the stay at Habitat Association all necessary veterinarian interventions will be done by the habitat Association vet on call.

Article 4. Habitat Association is not responsible for any illness, infectious or parasitic disease, when contact with the pathogenic entity was established prior to arrival at Habitat Association, or when the pet is handed over during a period of incubation.

Article 5. Habitat Association is not responsible for any medical problems or conditions which are impossible to foresee, prevent, diagnose or successfully treat (shock, anaphylactic or other allergic reactions, acute stomach dilatation, indigestion, invagination or bowel obstructions, stroke or heart attack, obstructive urolithiasis or other similar urgent conditions that will be treated by the Habitat Association vet on call)

In these cases the Habitat Association will do everything necessary and appropriate in order to minimize the consequences on the pet.

Article 6. Habitat Association is not responsible if unsterilized female dog becomes pregnant after staying at Habitat, if there was no specific mention of the female being in estrus upon handing the female dog over to the staff.

Article 7. All possible changes in weight, behaviour or habits, after returning from Habitat are physiological response to a stress situation due to a long or short stay in a new environment. When the owner takes the dog back, all responsibility concerning any illness or injury of Habitat Association stops.

Article 8. The pet's owner will be held accountable for all material damages done by his/her pet during his/her stay at Habitat.

Article 9. Reservation of the term is ensured only after regular application and payment of 30% of the total price of the pet's stay, for the dates written by the owner when handing over the pet.

Article 10. The pet's owner is obliged to hand over all necessary documents to the staff when handing over his/her pet to Habitat Association: confirmation of regular vaccination against rabies. The pet's owner is obliged to treat the pet for external and internal parasites.

Article 11. Reservation of the term is a part of this contract.

Article 12. If upon arrival or during the stay at Habitat we establish that the pet has fleas, ticks or other ectoparasites, we will do the necessary treatment at the owner's expense. If with these preventive measures, during the pet's stay at Habitat, the pet gets in contact with ectoparasites, we will do the same treatment seven days later, or on the day the pet is leaving Habitat, if the pet is staying with us longer than seven days, at the owner's expense.

Article 13. If the pet's owner does not take the pet back at the agreed term, or if the person authorised in this contract by the owner does not take the pet back, and if this delay is not explained or announced, every day of the pet's extra stay is calculated at 50% higher rate than the agreed price.

If the pet's owner, or if the person authorised in this contract by the owner does not take the pet back 3 days after the agreed term, and pays all the pet's expenses for the duration of the pet's stay at Habitat, the pet will be handed over to the authorised pet shelter, according to the Animal protection law, articles 55. and 56.

Article 14. All contracting parties are obliged to resolve any possible conflicts and disagreements in this contract in a peaceful way, and if they are not able to do so, to contract real and local jurisdiction of the Municipal court in Osijek.
